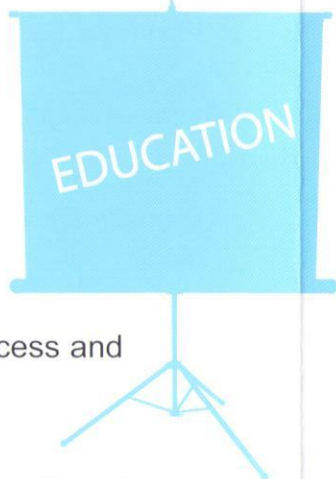
We have information on many other services and can arrange referrals and appointments for you.
