Found ations Project is an education project for people who are homeless. Our Child and Family Services are for families who are homeless, but we also take referrals from social workers, teachers etc.

We provide after schools activities and education support to groups of children depending on age. These run throughout the week. We also provide One-2-One sessions for children who need extra support.

We run a four week summer project, with lots of excursions and also run other trips throughout the year.
